Wed 26th February - Sat 11th April Many churches use the period of the year called Lent as a time for reflection. Before the solemnity of Good Friday and the glory of the resurrection on Easter Day, Christians have the opportunity to remember Christ's withdrawal into the desert for forty days. During these 40 days (Mon-Sat each week!) we take time to turn, seek God and to re-evaluate life with His perspective. This year the #LiveLent resources encourage us to think about the amazing gift of God's creation and how we can care for it better.
