We have about 80 young people overall attending Sunday mornings (11-14s), Sunday evenings (14-18s), or The Mix on Friday evenings (11-15). We are excited about the opportunity to look at different ways of discipling youth people in a post-pandemic world, both 'in-person' and online, within the wider vision and strategy of Christchurch.

Our vision for young people in Welwyn Garden City is to go 'Deeper and Wider'.

Deeper: to help young people at Christchurch dig deep roots in their faith, developing a love for God and for others. We want to help them to build a robust faith that steers them through the challenges of later teens and university, and empowers them to impact others through their lives.

Wider: to have a wide impact across the town, specifically by developing our presence in the secondary schools in Welwyn Garden City. We see that there is lots of potential for work with young people in this town, and long for doors, as well as hearts and minds, to be opened to the good news of Jesus.

We are therefore looking for an individual who:

- Is a committed Christian.
- Loves being with young people and has a passion for discipling others.
- Wants to commit to the long-term growth of a youth ministry.

- Has experience of growing leaders, building teams, and is good at delegating tasks to others.

- Has the ability to inspire others and provide pastoral leadership and direction.

- Is creative in their means of developing youth participation and engagement.

- Can grow young leaders through mentoring and internships.

- Can work with the Children and Families' Ministry Leader to help children transition from Children's work to Youth work.

- Has good understanding of culture and contemporary issues.

- Has good knowledge of safeguarding issues and procedure.

- Can develop vision and strategy alongside the youth core team.

- Can maintain effective working relationships with other relevant agencies, churches, and partners involved in youth provision.

- has excellent communication skills with people of different ages.

- has experience of recruiting and developing volunteers.

- can give evidence of continuous personal & professional. development.

- Good IT skills.

Desirable but not essential:
